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**RESOLUTION NO. 11-R-13**

1           **A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF ABERDEEN,**  
2           **MARYLAND, AUTHORIZING A REAL PROPERTY TAX CREDIT AGAINST THE**  
3           **CITY PROPERTY TAX IMPOSED ON THE ELIGIBLE ASSESSMENT FOR**  
4           **PROPERTY IN THE GREATER ABERDEEN/HAVRE DE GRACE ENTERPRISE**

13           **WHEREAS**, the State of Maryland has approved the designation of a portion of the  
14 Greater Aberdeen/Havre de Grace area as an Enterprise Zone; and

15  
16           **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council on April 11, 2006 approved the submission of  
17 an application for the Greater Aberdeen/Havre de Grace Enterprise Zone; and

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19           **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council on February 27, 2006 adopted Resolution No.  
20 690-06 supporting the Greater Aberdeen-Havre de Enterprise Zone designation for a period of  
21 ten years.


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23           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and City Council, that the  
24 property known as 110 North Philadelphia Boulevard, Aberdeen, Maryland 21001, receive a  
25 real property tax credit against City taxes for Fiscal Year 2012 and continuing for nine (9)  
26 consecutive years thereafter; and

28           **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the amount of the tax credit shall be equal to a  
29 percentage of the amount of the property tax imposed on the eligible assessment of the qualified  
30 property as follows:

- 32 (1) 80% in each of the 1<sup>st</sup> five (5) taxable years following the calendar year in which the  
33 property initially becomes a qualified property;  
34  
35 (2) 70% in the 6<sup>th</sup> taxable year;  
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37 (3) 60% in the 7<sup>th</sup> taxable year;  
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39 (4) 50% in the 8<sup>th</sup> taxable year;  
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41 (5) 40% in the 9<sup>th</sup> taxable year;  
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43 (6) 30% in the 10<sup>th</sup> taxable year;  
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
45 **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the credit should first apply to the tax bill for  
46 real property taxes for 2012-13.


